## The Wage Gap

Median annual pay for a woman is\* \$38,774. Median annual pay for a man is\* \$48,001.

\*Oregon wage gap for full-time, year round jobs.

This means that women in Oregon are paid 81 cents for every dollar paid to men, amounting to an annual wage gap of \$9,227.

12 additional months of child care.
